Processing applicant data

This privacy statement explains how we process personal data. This statement tells you, the data subject, how we process your personal data and what your rights are and how you can exercise them. Provisions on the content of the statement, the rights of the data subject etc. are laid down in the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679.

The processing of personal data refers to activities concerning the personal data of natural persons, e.g. you, and datasets containing personal data. Personal data processing may occur in data systems or manually, e.g. on paper or in conversation. The processing of personal data includes activities such as the collection, recording, organisation, storage, modification, transfer, aggregation, disclosure and publication as well as the erasure and destruction of data.

Purpose of processing

Legal basis for processing

The processing of applicant data for vocational training and training preparatory to degree training is based on statutory obligations.

Retention period of personal data

Data on applications will be stored for 10 years.

4. Data subjects

Data on the following categories of persons are processed in the processing activity:

Applicants are people interested in REDU's vocational education or training courses. Applicants can also be minors (15 - 17 years old).

6. Personal data disclosure and publication

Personal data disclosure

Applicant information may be disclosed to the competent authority on a statutory basis. Information on applicants subject to the Act on Compulsory Education, for example, may be disclosed to another education or training provider on the basis of the Act.

Transfer of personal data outside the EU

No personal data is transferred outside the EU.

Personal data publication

On the application, the applicant may consent to their name and study programme applied to being published on a public website on the Internet if they are admitted to the programme.

7. Information systems, information security and manual processing of personal data

Information systems and/or information pools used in processing activities:

Information security in information systems and/or information pools with regard to the processing of personal data shall be ensured as follows:

Application forms use a secure connection. Access to applicant information in the systems requires two-step verification from the user.

Manual processing of personal data or documents used for processing of personal data:

You will be informed about your study place (invitation letter) by email and/or text message or by post.

In manual processing, data security is ensured as follows:

If the decision to inform about a study place and/or to accept a student contains confidential personal information, the message will be sent encrypted or via secure mail.

8. Rights of data subjects and exercise thereof

Under the Data Protection Regulation, you have the rights listed below.
